The attainment data shows that 100% of our FSM children achieved L4+ in reading, writing, maths and combined R/W/M in 2015. This is above Kent FSM and above 'All' - both for Kent and National. Year 6 children, who were eligible for FSM, also achieved a higher percentage of Level 5+ in reading, writing and maths than Kent FSM. They also achieved a higher percentage of Level 5+ in reading and maths than 'All' children nationally.

The progress data shows 100% of our FSM children made two levels of progress. This is above Kent FSM, Kent 'All' and National 'All'. The percentage of FSM children making three levels of progress, in reading, writing and maths, is also above Kent FSM and Kent 'All'.
