

Key Stage 2 Homework Policy

A selection of home learning activities linked to current learning and designed to develop a range of skills will be sent home each term by class teachers.

Children will be asked to choose one task to complete each week which should then be recorded and returned to school.

The way that homework is recorded and returned will depend on the task, for example: in the child's homework book, uploaded onto Class Dojo, a photo, a comment from a parent/carer, a written review of the task etc.

Reading

All Key Stage 2 children should read at least three times a week. Reading records need to be completed and brought into school daily.

Year 3 and 4 children should read to an adult at home. The adult who has heard the child read should please complete their reading record commenting on their reading.

Year 5 and 6 children can choose to either read to an adult or read independently. If they have read independently then they should complete their reading record themselves commenting on what they have read.

Multiplication Tables

All Key Stage 2 children will be set a weekly times table to learn which they will be tested on in school. They should practise as often as possible at home. Please remember to use Times Table Rockstars to support with this.

Spelling

Teachers will set weekly spelling words for the children to learn which they will be tested on in school. They should practise as often as possible at home. Word lists will be available on EdShed which also has a number of games and resources to help the children learn their spellings.
