




Year 1 - Summer 1

Top Tips

The secret to success is practising **little** and **often**. Use time wisely. Can you practise these KIRFs while walking to school or during a car journey? - Adapt songs such as 20 fat sausages sizzling in the pan to count up or down in 2s
