



## Year 6 - Spring 2

I can tell the time and use time tables to solve time problems.

*By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts **instantly**.*

Children need to be able to tell the time using a clock with hands and a digital clock. This target can be broken down into several steps.

- I can tell the time to the nearest five minutes.
- I can tell the time using a digital clock
- I can convert digital time to analogue time
- I can answer questions about time duration
- I can read a time table
- Solve time problems

**Example - Time to cook a turkey**  
**Cook for 45 min per kg weight**  
**Then a further 45 min**

For a 6 kg turkey, follow the formula:  
 $45\text{min} \times 6 + 45\text{min}$   
 $= 270\text{min} + 45\text{min}$   
 $= 315\text{min}$   
 $= 5\text{h } 15\text{min}$
