AIMS OF THE SCHOOL

Our school aims to:

- e. Celebrate your child's academic and personal achievements.
- f. Expect high standards of behaviour and promote respect for all.
- g. Monitor your child's progress and provide advice and guidance over their work.
- h. Care for your child's safety and well-being.
- i. Notify parents of any concerns relating to your child's progress or conduct.

I, as Parent or Carer, will:

- a. Make sure my child arrives at school on time (8.43-8.50) and be suitably prepared for the day.
- b. Let the school know of any concerns or problems that might affect my child's learning, behaviour or well-being.
- c. Attend Parents' Meetings to review my child's progress.
- d. Support the school's rules and expectations as set out in the Homework Policy.
- e. Make sure my child attends regularly and provide a note of explanation if my child is absent.
- f. Ensure my child has correct school uniform and PE equipment – all named.
- g. Ensure the school is notified of any change in emergency contact numbers.
- h. Support the school in the teaching of safe and secure internet use at school and at home.
- i. Read all information sent home as this gives me important details of relevant policies, Parents' Meetings, Parents' Dropins, Church Services, trips and activities.
- j. Provide a supportive environment to complete homework and ensure it is completed and returned on time.

As a pupil I will

- a. I will always try to do my best.
- b. I will respect our Christian Values and follow the school rules.
- c. Respect other people's culture, race, feelings, beliefs and values.
- d. Tell a member of staff if I am worried or unhappy.
- e. Do my class work and homework as well as I can.
- f. Come to school on time with the things I need.
- g. Wear my school uniform with pride and be tidy in my appearance.
- h. Accept responsibility for the things that I do.
- i. I will take good care of the equipment and building.
