The Bible points out that his birth showed that he was extraordinary (for example, he is worshipped as a king, in Matthew) and that he came to bring good news (for example, to the poor, in Luke).  Christians celebrate Jesus' birth, and Advent for Christians is a time for getting	Christians believe Jesus brings good news for all people.  For Christians, this good news includes being loved by God, and being forgiven for bad things.  Christians believe Jesus is a friend to the poor and friendless. Jesus showed that he was willing to forgive all people, even for putting him on the cross.  Christians believe Jesus builds a bridge between God and humans.
