Can you design your own?</p>	<p>Count forwards and backwards to 100 This could be done through: *Playing Snakes and Ladders. *My Number, Your Number One person says a number and the next person says a number. Which number can you reach in one minute?</p>	<p>Illustrate a page from a book you are reading at home. What does the book tell you about the setting? Is it in a forest? A busy city? What other details in the book can you add to your illustration?</p>	<p>This term we are learning about continents and oceans. Can you research and find out any facts about one of the seven continents or one of the oceans? You could include pictures, drawings, anything you like!</p> 
<p>This term we will be reading the poem 'Don't!', by Michele Rosen. Listen to some of Michele Rosen's other poems. Are there any you like? Can you draw or write about the poem and what you liked? Perhaps you can perform one and send it in to class!</p>	<p>This term, we are working hard on numbers to 100. Practise correctly forming numbers 1-100. You could practise using pens, paint, chalk, in sand or even try creating numbers using natural materials. Challenge yourself further by finding a way to represent the number...for example, 42...do you have 42...soft cuddly toys?</p>	<p>Choose a favourite book to read. Tell your adult what happens in the story. Who is your favourite character? Draw a picture of your favourite character and write a sentence to explain why you like them.</p>	<p>We are reading the book 'Perfectly Norman' who grew wings! Can you draw what you would look if you grew wings? Are they colourful like Normans? Draw where you would fly to!</p> 	<p>Where have you flown to? Can you research and find out three facts about the place you have visited by flying there with your wings?</p>
