The children will also be set up on Timestable Rockstars ready for term 2, which is an online platform with games and activities to support learning timestables. We will send home log ins for both.

On Friday, we will do a mini quiz on the spellings and timestables they've been learning that week but we will be making it very casual, they don't need to worry about how many they get right or wrong as I will not be asking them to share their scores. This should support any children who may worry about doing weekly mini quizzes.
