Can you draw and label them? What plants are in your environment?</p>	<p>What can you discover about the Romans? What did they like to eat? How did they create music? What Gods did they believe in? What were their sport or leisure activities?</p>

Can you design, draw and colour one in or make it with cut out paper?</p>	<p><b>Romans Maths</b>            Learn the Roman numerals up to 12.</p> <p>Find the year the Romans invaded Britain and the year they left Britain. Draw a number line to work out how many years they ruled here.</p>
