Addition and Subtraction:

Add and subtract two numbers.

Add and subtract two numbers across tens and hundreds.

Add and subtract a three-digit and two-digit number.

Estimate numbers, inverse operations and problem solving.

RE – Sikhism. What is important for Sikh people?

- Sikhs believe that there is only one God, who they have several names for (Waheguru).
- Sikhs try to put the teachings and examples of the 10 gurus into daily practice by living a good life, treating everyone equally and sharing all they have.
- It is important for Sikh's to belong to a community of believers called the Khalsa.
- Khalsa Sikhs wear 5 articles of faith which reminds them of their faith and duty as a Sikh.

Science – Light and Shadows

- To notice that light is reflected from surfaces.
- To recognise that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by a solid object.
- To find patterns in the way that the sizes of shadows change.
- The moon is not a source of light.
